## LAST MEETING:

The Exchange Club of North Jackson met on Tuesday, May 5, 2009, at Western Sizzlin Restaurant. Angela Butler, president, called the meeting to order. She welcomed our guests from the Mississippi Trooper Association and the winners of our school competitions and their families. James Gould gave the invocation and Katherine Gould led the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag. We all then enjoyed the Western Sizzlin buffet.

The anniversary recognized this month was James and Katherine Gould; there were no birthdays. We were updated on members and family who've recently been under the weather, and were reminded of the District Convention in June and the National Convention in July. James Gould, chairman of the Trooper of the Year Committee, said that the statewide Trooper of the Year Banquet and recognition will be Monday, May 18 at 12:00 Noon

at the Western Sizzlin Restaurant. We will try to decorate for the banquet Sunday afternoon if that is OK with the restaurant. Diane Sullivan said that Berkey Fellowship contributions are due soon.

Angela called on James Gould to introduce our Mississippi Trooper guests. He told us that the trooper recognition was started by Brunner Huddleston in appreciation of the work of our men in uniform. Each local troop in the state selects a winner; from these an overall honoree is chosen. Master Sergeant Jacob Sheriff came forward to tell us about Corporal Scott Henley of Troop C, describing him as dedicated, hardworking, and dependable. Cpl. Henley was presented with a plaque recognizing his accomplishment. After thanking club members, he was warmly applauded.

Each year a student who is qualified as Accepting the Challenge of Excellence (ACE) is recognized for having overcome obstacles in his life to succeed in his education. Marilyn McGreggor, counselor at New Summit School in Jackson, said the school started out with 55 students and has expanded to 125 with a 10/1 ratio of students/teachers, allowing more personalized instruction. John Kibble is the winner of the ACE award; his mother, Betty Kibble accompanied him. Mrs. Kibble adopted John, her grandson, at the age of 4. John plans to attend Hinds Community College to study welding and then go further, perhaps, with his education. He will graduate from New Summit School this year.

Angela then introduced our Youth of the Year winner, Virginia Edwards, who was accompanied by her parents, Dr. Joe Edwards and Gail Edwards. She was selected from the all Youth of the Month

winners and will graduate from University Christian School in Flowood. She graciously read her winning essay which will be entered in the District competition in Cleveland and, if a winner, in the National competition in Jacksonville, Florida. Good luck, Virginia—we think you are a winner.

There were rounds of applause for our student winners, and Ken Sullivan presented John and Virginia with plaques and checks for their accomplishments. We wish them both the best.
